

John Hall Memorial Service Award

Introduction

This document formalises the details of the John Hall Memorial Service Award, created by Orienteering SA in 2002. It is a perpetual plaque that is awarded annually and symbolises the spirit of those who work tirelessly to make orienteering available to members. John Hall was one of these people and he held the executive role of Secretary (2000 – 2002) when he died suddenly in August 2002. Recipients will also receive a mounted certificate as a permanent memento.

Conditions for the Award

To be considered worthy of the John Hall Memorial Award, a person would have rendered meritorious service to the sport of orienteering within any club affiliated with Orienteering SA and/or at association level. The and/or implies that both are not required and this is considered appropriate since country clubs have difficulty contributing at association level. The recipient is the custodian of the plaque for a year prior to the presentation to the following year's recipient. The recipient name and the year will be engraved on the plaque.

Method of Award

Each club may nominate one deserving orienteering member or couple from the Orienteering SA community at large. Supporting documentation should be submitted to the Orienteering SA Secretary by the 30th of October each year or as determined by executive. The executive (President, Secretary and Treasurer or their nominee) will make the selection. The award would be presented normally at the annual Orienteering SA Presentation of Awards.
