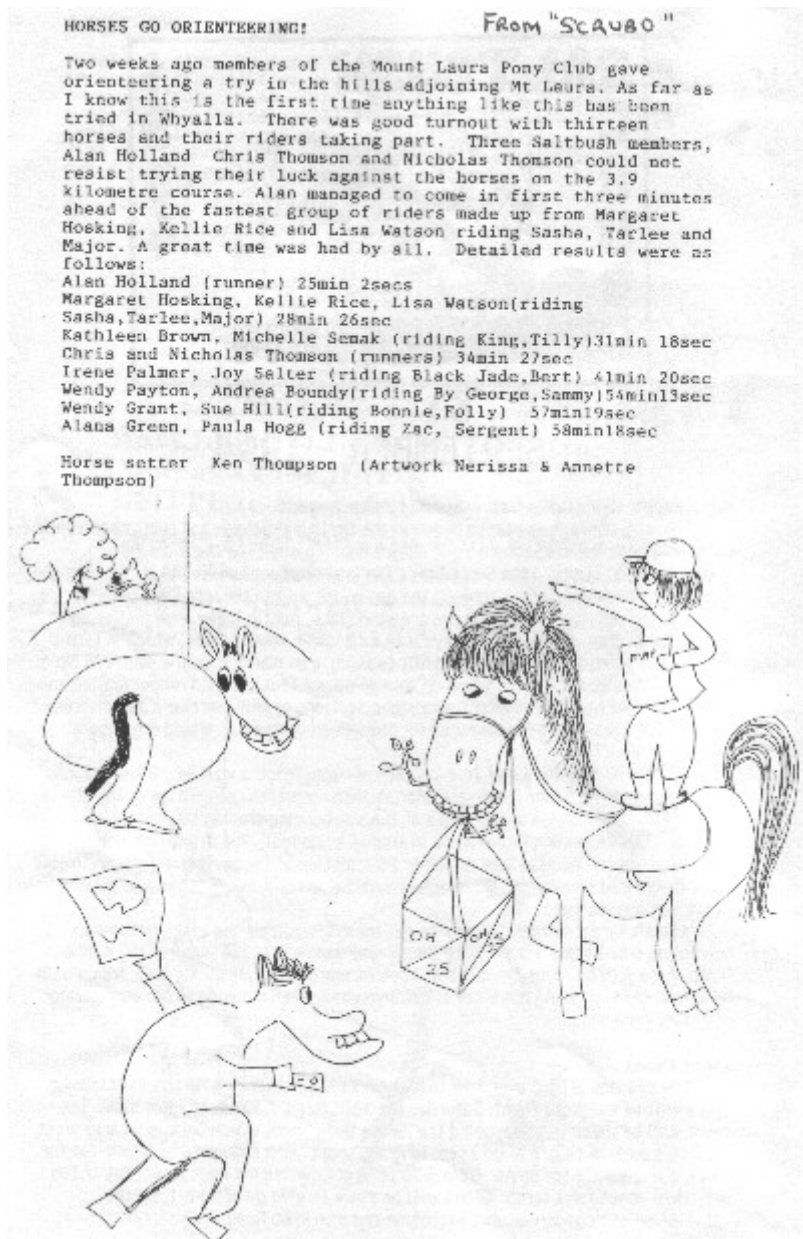


SALTBUSH MEMORIES FROM 1994
