

## Club History Corner

The Scouts' property 'Woodhouse' has been a Wallaringa map since being first drawn in 1991 by Tintookie orienteers Piotr (Peter) Czajkowski and John Lyon. This original version of the map is unusual because the vertical orientation lines are 200m apart instead of 250m (it is in a 1:5,000 scale). Recent versions have had Frank Tomas as the mapper, have far more detail and are of sprint orienteering standard.
