Is your School a Member of Orienteering SA?

Orienteering is a sport that involves map reading and navigation, as participants try to find their way around a set course in the quickest possible time.

It is a navigation strategy sport that develops skills in map-reading and decision making. It enhances physical fitness and an appreciation for the environment.

Hundreds of schoolchildren are already benefiting from their school's membership. If your school is not a member, get them to join up!

Membership is annual and gives schools lower entry fees at events for staff & students when they attend an Orienteering SA event, either as a supervised school group or when an individual student attends on their own or with their families.
