All runners had to be flexible to accommodate the activities of the ACC which moved hourly and had to be avoided. The police horses didn't have to be avoided, being denied the run of the Olive Paddock for those few hours.

All runners had to concentrate and rely on their own abilities, knowing their team mates were waiting for their speedy return---unlike the Individual Championships where the structure of the competition cannot avoid groups accumulating often without any drive to do their best. It is from the Relays we hope to attract younger (11-14) orienteers to the Camp in November and thus on to Schools selection trials in 2012. I recommend the Relays continue virtually in their present format as part of the OSA programme (after evaluating the use of electronic timing proposed for the 2012 Individual Championships).
